

Here are some tips for using the map:






Mel Stone

Fifteen years ago, upon arriving in Las Cruces, Mel Stone, a retired economist, professor, and world-renowned television news reporter, pursued his long-held dream of opening his own art gallery. He named it the Mesquite Art Gallery in honor of the neighborhood and street. As one of the first individuals in the area to preserve a historic adobe building, he valued the neighborhood's rich history and stories, transforming the adobe into his home, a photographic studio, and an art gallery.

In addition to the gallery, Mel was a well-established artist at the Las Cruces Farmers Market. He passed away this year at the age of 82

from pancreatic cancer. In tribute to Mel, his family and the 10 O'clock Club will continue to operate his gallery, allowing patrons to view his work and that of other artists.



Sterling Trantham

Sterling Trantham, 1957-2025, was a talented photographer from New Mexico. He earned three degrees in photography from New Mexico State University. As a photojournalist, he contributed work to various newspapers across New Mexico and worked as a freelance contractor for the Associated Press. His photographs were featured in major media outlets throughout the United States. In 1998, he began his career as an educator, teaching photography and photojournalism at NMSU and EPCC. His exceptional skills as an educator were recognized when he was awarded

the prestigious National Geographic Faculty Fellowship. Sterling dedicated years to photographing the Maya in Guatemala. His work has been exhibited at the Santa Fe Museum of Art, the Las Cruces Branigan Library, Mad Hatter Gallery, and the Fort Collins Museum of Art in Colorado. 




